KEI Semesters

These are the exact start and end dates of the semesters for all the schools and all of the core class dates fit within these dates:

Fall 2014 Semester starts from September 12, 2014, and ending the week of January 10, 2015.

Winter 2015 Semester starts from February 13, 2015, and ending the week of June 13, 2015.

KEI Core Classes*

(Monday or Tuesday 6:30 pm – 8:00 pm)

Core classes are held once a week for 5 weeks each and are a part of the Equipping Schools. Students are required to attend these classes during their enrollment in any of the Equipping Schools during that semester.

Hearing the Voice of God (formally MSG)

This class teaches the basics of how to hear the voice of the Holy Spirit, done through teaching about the revelatory and vocal gifts. Practical application and experiential learning will take place during each class period.

Fall 2014 Semester: Starts the week of September 15, 2014, ends the week of October 13, 2014

Winter 2015 Semester: Starts the week of February 16, 2015, ends the week of March 16, 2015

How to Study The Bible

This class will help you develop the skills that you need to make your time in God's Word rewarding. You will learn how to cultivate strong Bible study habits, understand key teachings and verses, and find major themes, principles and promises.

Fall 2014 Semester: Starts the week of October 27, 2014, ends the week of November 24, 2014

Winter 2015 Semester: Starts the week of March 30, 2015, ends the week of April 27, 2015

10 M's

This class will help you understand how Christ wants to help you develop your character in His image and likeness. This will be done through the study of the 10 M's and some of the character pitfalls to avoid.

Winter 2015 Semester: Starts the week of May 11, 2015, ends the week of June 8, 2015

Equipping Schools*

(Friday 7:00 pm and Saturday 9:00 am – 4:00 pm)

Classes are typically held on the 2nd Friday and Saturday of each month at the start of each semester. Friday night class starts at 7pm until dismissed. Saturday classes usually are held 9am to 4pm unless otherwise

determined by the instructor. The time investment for each course will be approximately 10-15 hours a month depending on the course of study. Completion of the course is based on a pass/fail system contingent upon completing the assignments outlined in the curriculum (exception Ministers in Training and School of Eldership).

NEW School of Healing

(Inner Healing, Deliverance, Physical Healing)

Inner Healing Block 1 (Sponsored by Living Waters Healing Center - Marcy Wujkowski)

Inner Healing Block I is designed to teach and equip the foundational principles of inner healing ministry including the biblical basis for inner healing, understanding soul wounds, the structures of healing, activating gifts of healing and much more. In this course you will learn how healing and transforming the inner man is part of God's design for living in wholeness through the power of the Holy Spirit.
